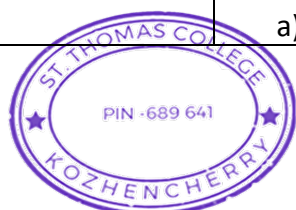

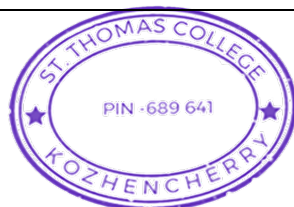

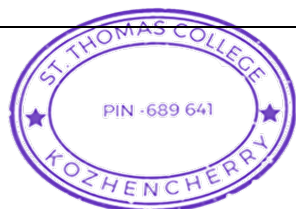

#### **4. ONE-DAY HANDS-ON WORKSHOP- "ONE MILLION GALAXIES- A CITIZEN SCIENCE PROGRAMME"**

"One Million Galaxies"- One Day Hands-On Citizen Science Programme was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of St. Thomas College, Kozhencherry in collaboration with Pune Knowledge Cluster on 21st February 2024 at Dr. Juhanon MarThoma Hall. Pune Knowledge Cluster, one among the six knowledge clusters initiated by the Principal Scientific Advisor, Govt. of India. Pune Knowledge Cluster (PKC) was established by Inter-University Centre for Astronomy and Astrophysics (IUCAA) Pune. "One million Galaxies"- a citizen Science program, a focus area of the Pune Knowledge cluster, aims to connect citizens to the frontiers of current scientific projects and to promote scientific curiosity amongst the citizens. Through this program, all interested citizens are invited to analyze salient features from astronomical images taken by large telescopes and to help create big data that to be used to understand the nature of galaxies. The programme included talks by astronomers, training sessions on how to classify galaxies, and an opportunity for participants to interact with scientists.

The inaugural session of the programme started at 9.30 a.m. and the College Principal, Dr. George K. Alex presided over the function. Dr. Prathibha Vasudevan, co-ordinator of the programme welcomed the gathering. Prof. Dr. Ajith Khembhavi (Emeritus Professor from IUCAA, Pune and Principal Investigator of PKC), the distinguished astrophysicist inaugurated the programme and led the introductory talk on the topic "Galaxies- Finding the features". Dr. Sudhanshu Barway, Associate Professor from the Indian Institute of Astrophysics, Bengaluru led an invited talk on "PKC Citizen Science Project". Following the informative talks, two expert astrophysicists Dr. Disha Sawant and Mr. Atharva Pathak (team members of PKC) conducted training sessions for the participants.

About 55 people attended the programme and got benefited from the experience of eminent speakers. The participants came from various backgrounds, including students, teachers, and research scholars. The participants engaged in a series of captivating galactic image analyses designed to stimulate their curiosity about astronomy and the vastness of space. They all reported that they learned a lot from the program and were excited to get involved in the citizen science project. The hands-on training session provided valuable insights, leaving the students not only with newfound knowledge but also with a burning curiosity to explore the world of astrophysics further. Educational initiatives like this serve as catalysts for nurturing young minds passionate about science and innovation. Overall, the "One Million Galaxies" program was a valuable event that helped to promote public understanding of science and astronomy. The One Day Citizen Science program was an unequivocal success, providing students with an exceptional platform to explore and appreciate the marvels of science. It was an incredibly enriching experience that not only trained but also educated, leaving an indelible impact on everyone involved. Mr. Shinu Koshy, IQAC co-ordinator of the college, delivered the vote of thanks, to bring the workshop to its conclusion.
