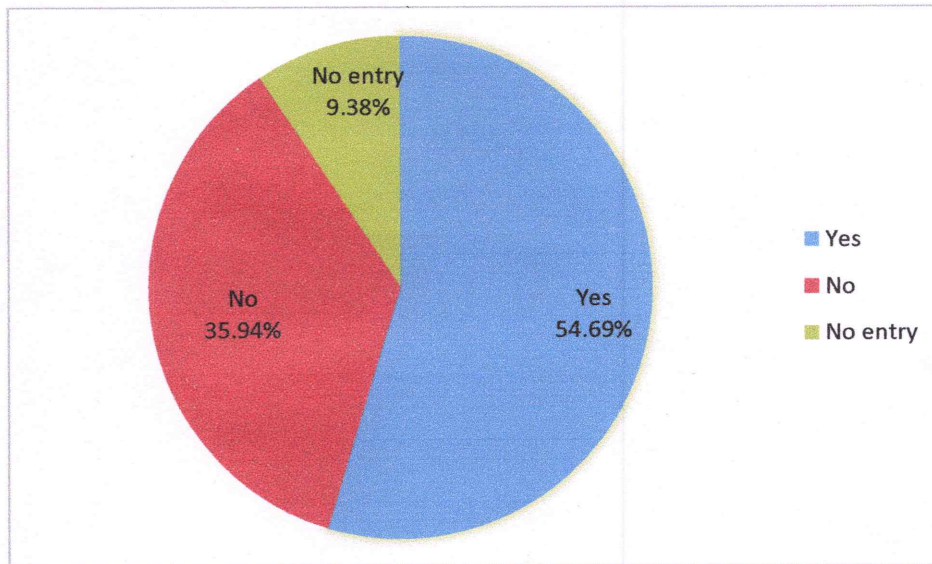

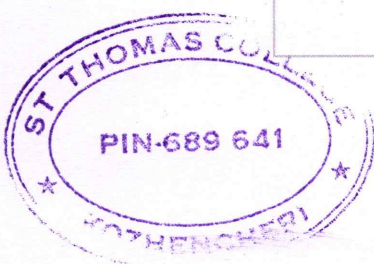
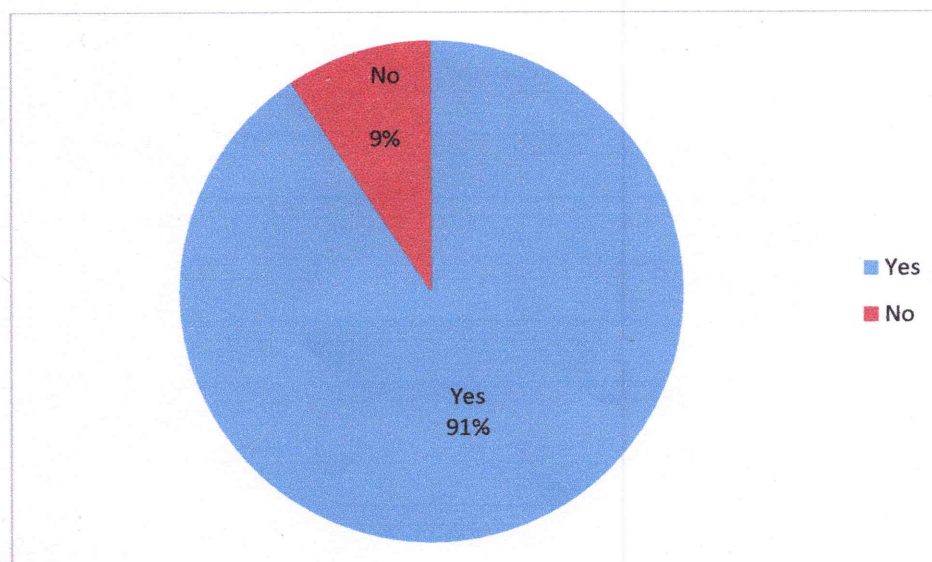
## Feedback on Curriculum by Teachers

**Question 1 : How did you find the curriculum?**



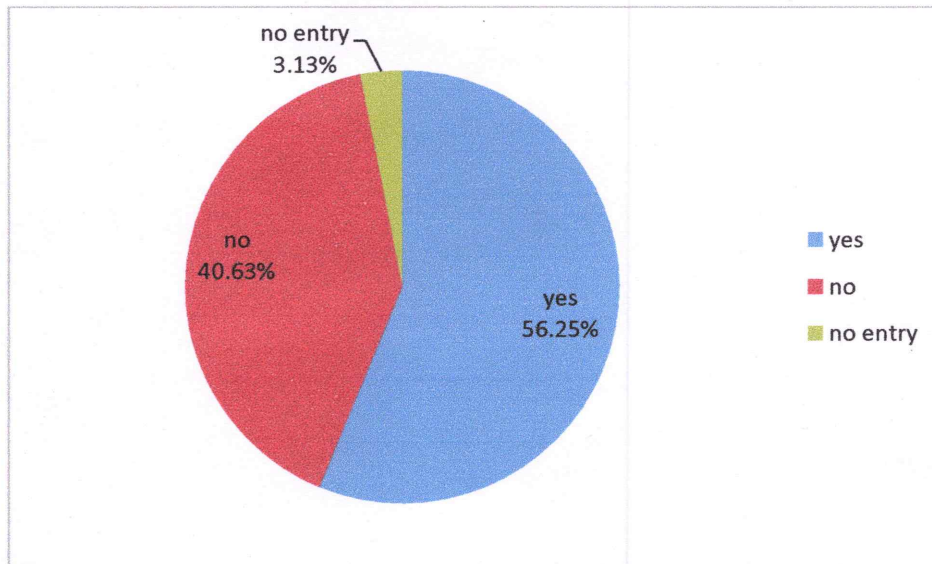

**Question 2 : Were instructions easy to follow?**



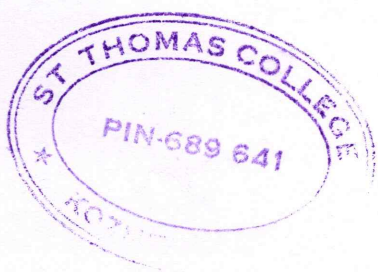
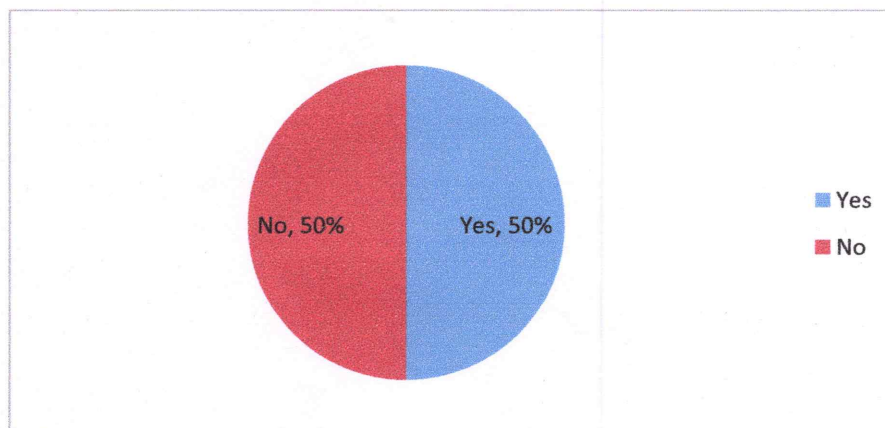

**Question 3 : Whether the subjects relevant to industry prevailing demand?**



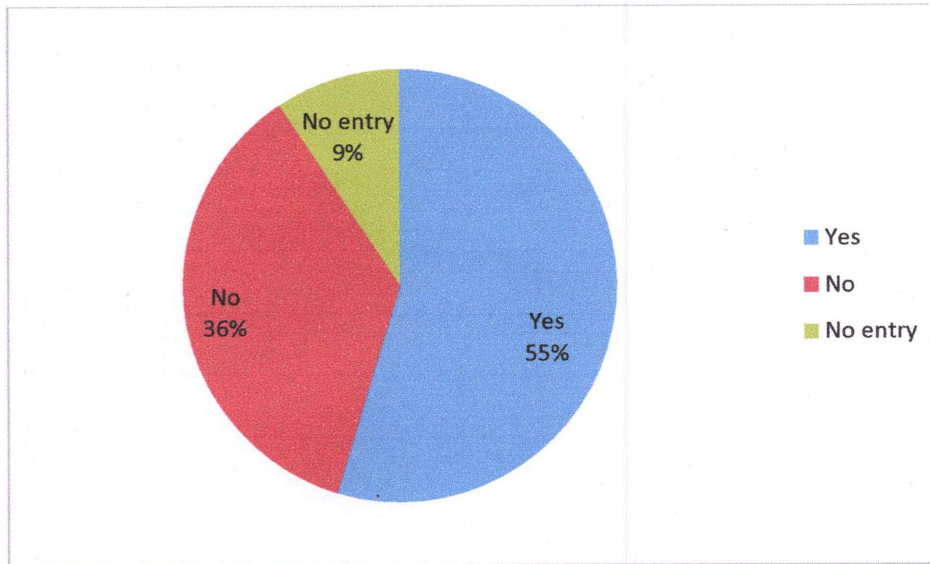

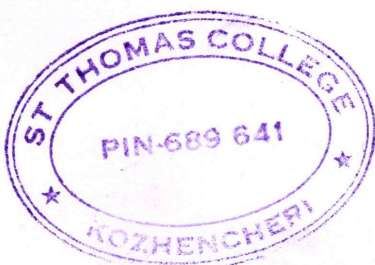
Most of the teachers found the curriculum, easy.

According to majority of teachers, subjects should be related to what employers want.

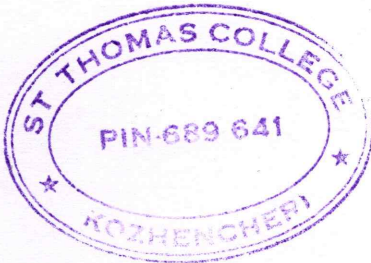
Regarding the direct applicability of subjects for a job, half of the respondents were positive.

Teachers have made some crucial recommendations. Teachers had doubts about how important the curriculum was for employability. The smallest intricacies of numerous topics, in their view, don't matter as much practically. According to some educators, the curriculum has to be revised and needs to provide more direction for internships. Concerning the syllabus' suitability for students who want to become teachers, the syllabus was apt. The future employment chances of students are being harmed by exam-focused curriculum and the addition of more traditional subjects.

Most teachers chose project work, practical lessons, and industry trips as the most beneficial elements of the curricula. There were so many teachers who questioned the value of the Open Course and thought it was irrelevant.
