## Student Satisfaction Survey and Course Evaluation-2023-24

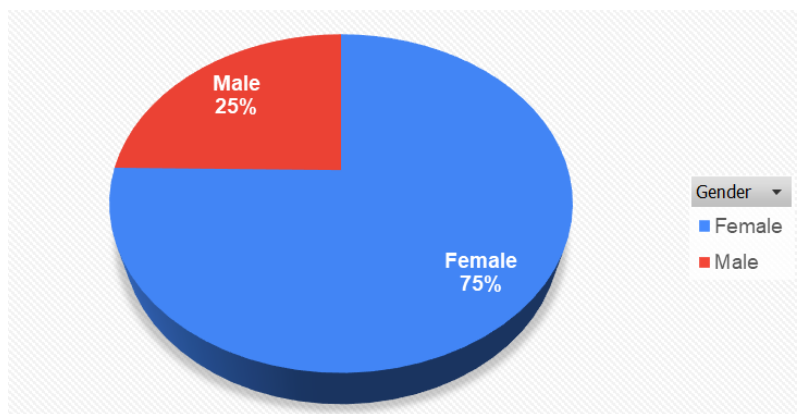

## Introduction

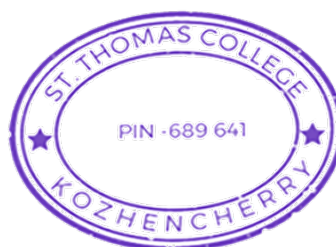
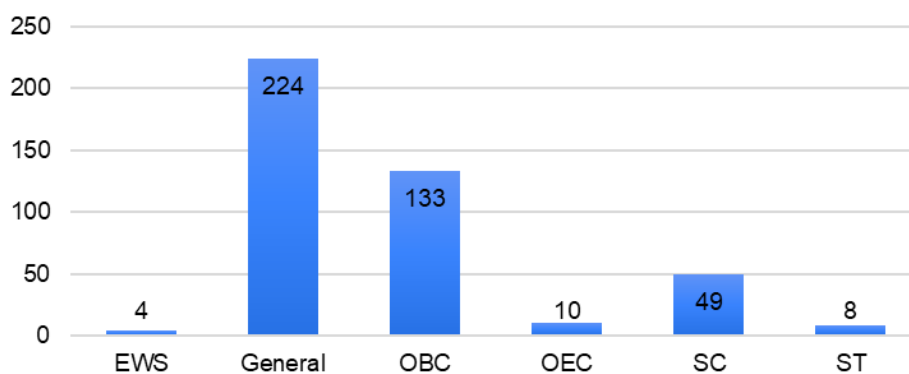
We have carried out a student satisfaction survey to gauge the success of curriculum delivery and the relationship between students and teachers at our institution. A Google Form was used to conduct the survey, which was conducted from January to May, 2024. There are 17 questions under three different categories that were asked on the survey to evaluate the effort of the students in learning, learning outcomes, and skill and effectiveness of the faculty. A total of 428 responses have been received. The data is collected on a representative basis.

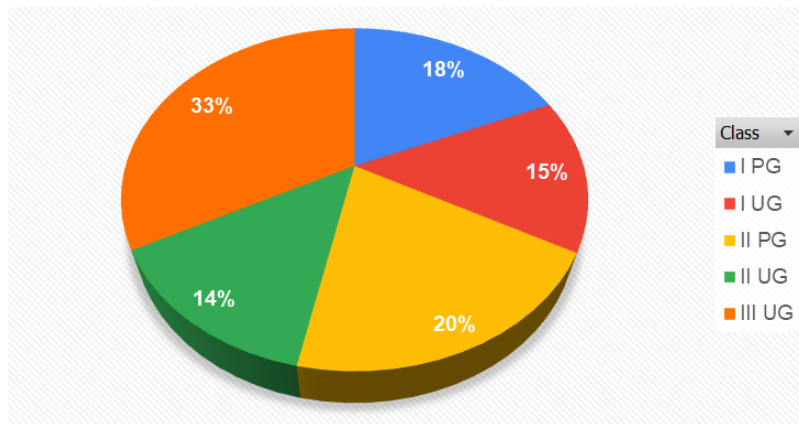
Among the 428 responses received, 75% of the responses are from female students. The details are given below.

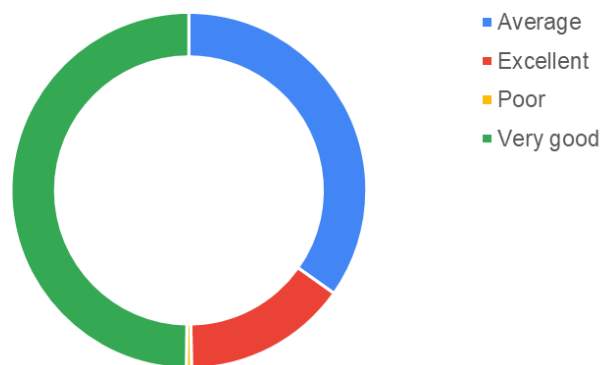

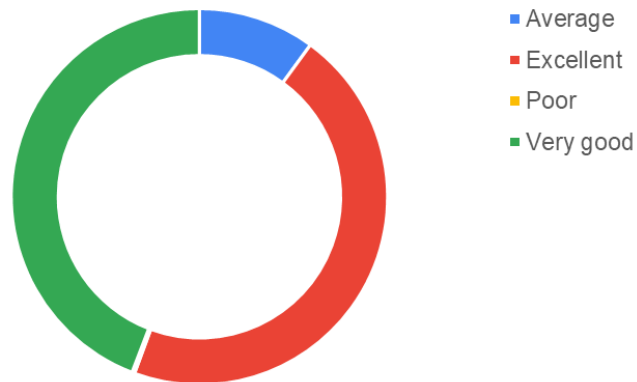

## 2. Are you regular in attending the classes?



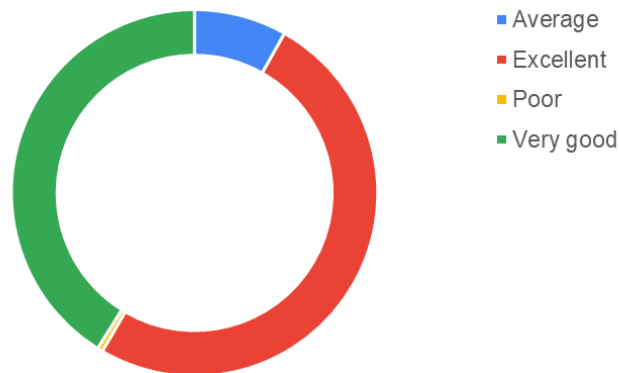

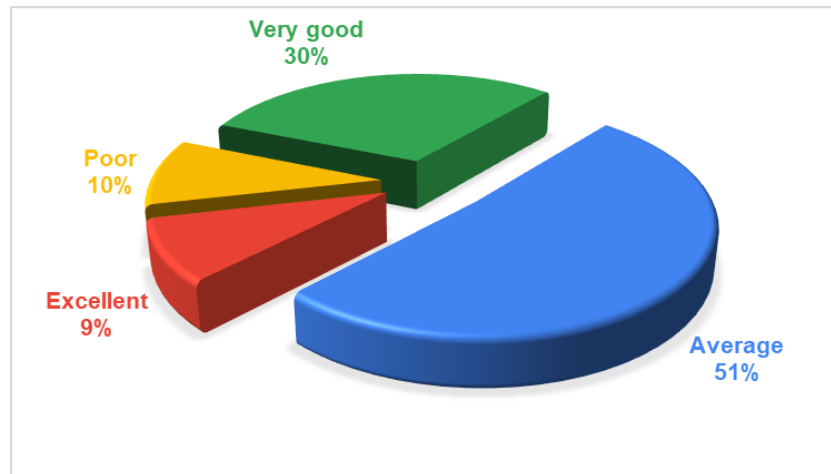

### 1. Level of skill/knowledge at start of course

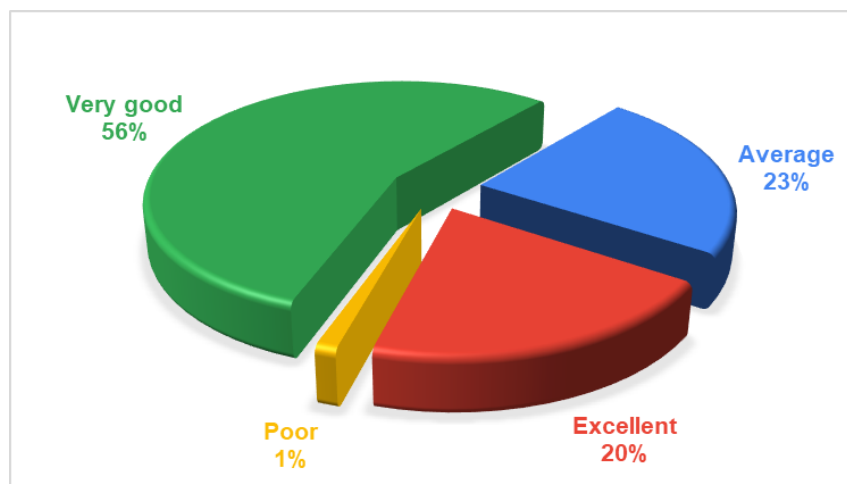

### 2. Level of skill/knowledge at end of course

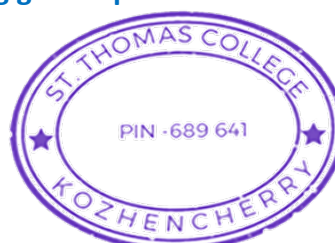

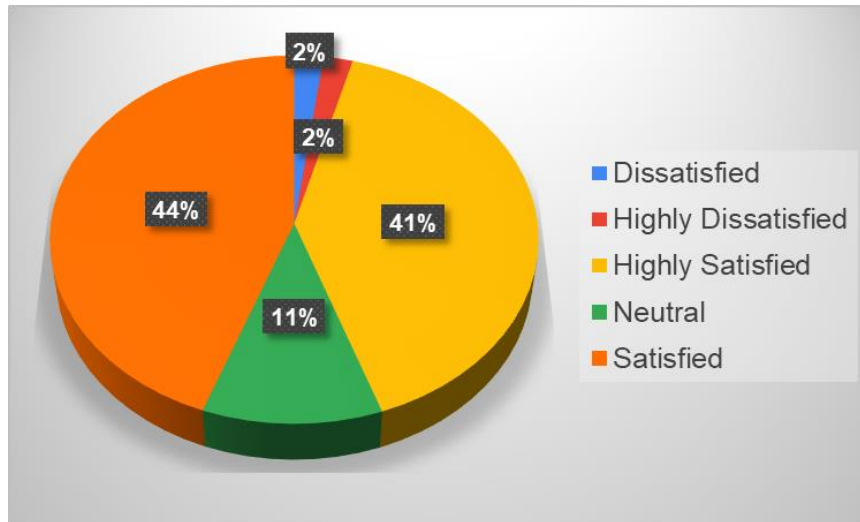

#### 1. Punctuality and Regularity of the teacher in taking class

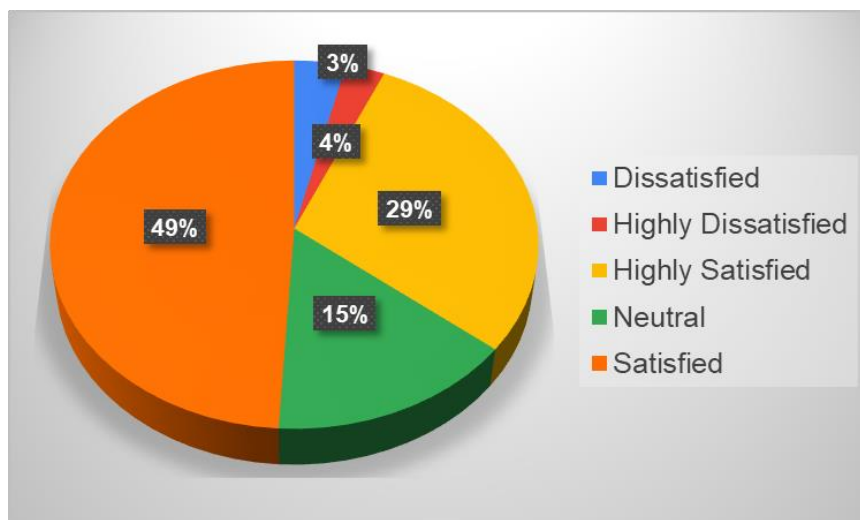

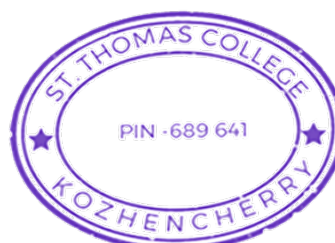
#### 2. Are the course outcomes explained to you by the faculty?



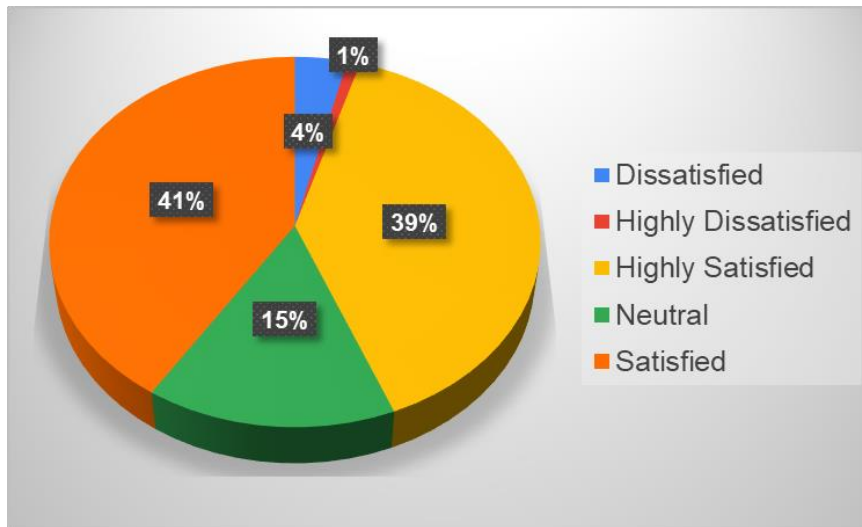

### 3. Class was clear and organized based on syllabus

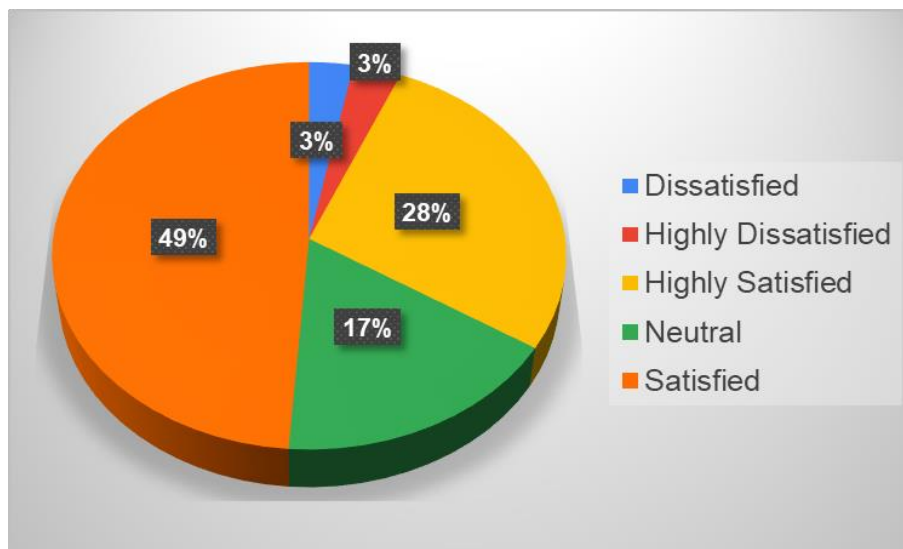

### 4. Does the teacher stimulate the interest of students in the course?



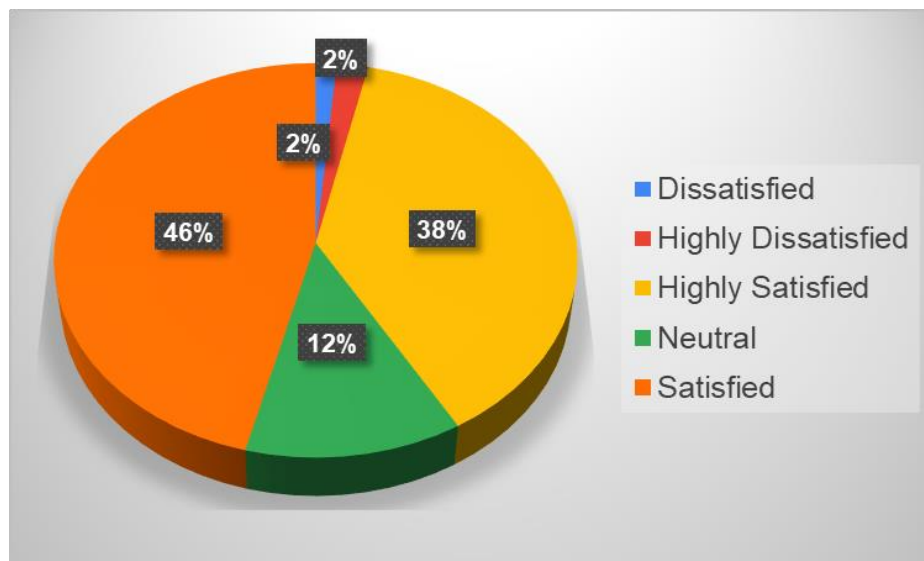

5. Does the teacher(s) effectively use the time during class periods?

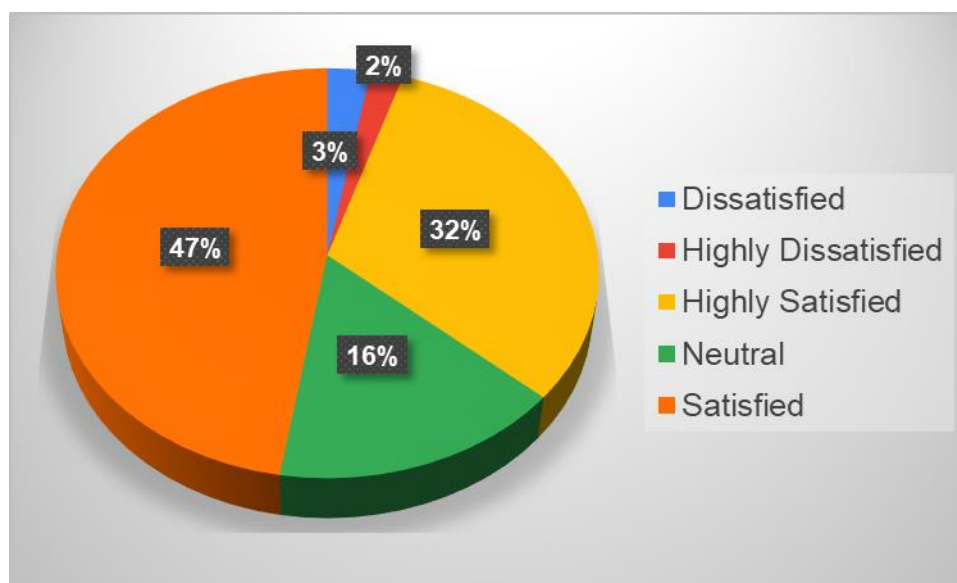

6. How effectively does the faculty communicate the content and course outcomes they teach?



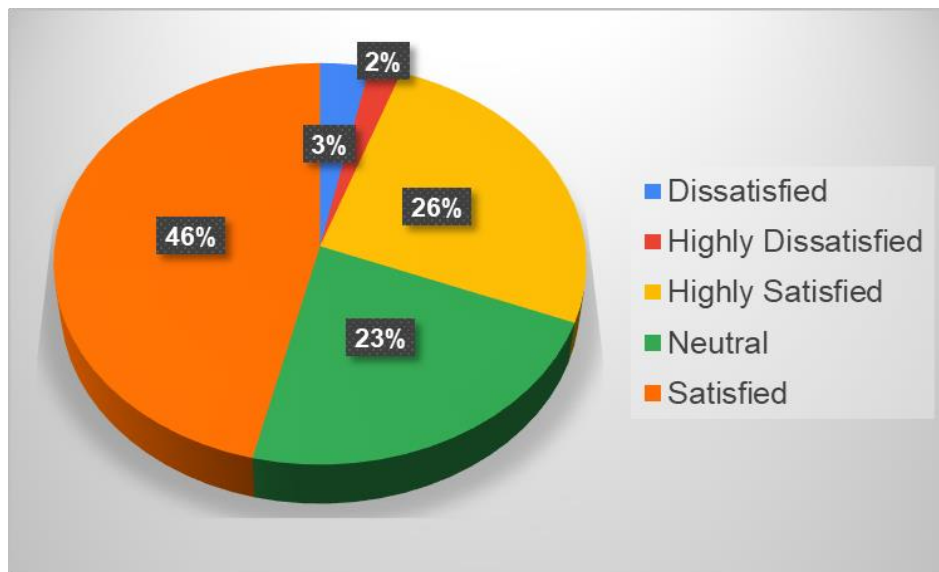

7. Are student-centric methods, like participative learning and problem-solving methods, used for enhancing the learning process?

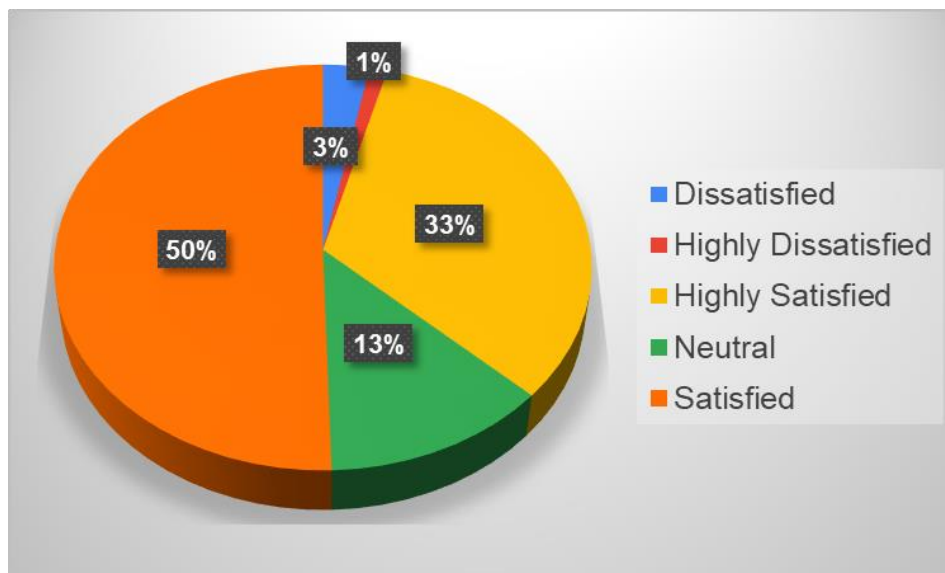

8. Does the teacher(s) use examples and analogies to explain concepts in order to make the course interesting and relevant?

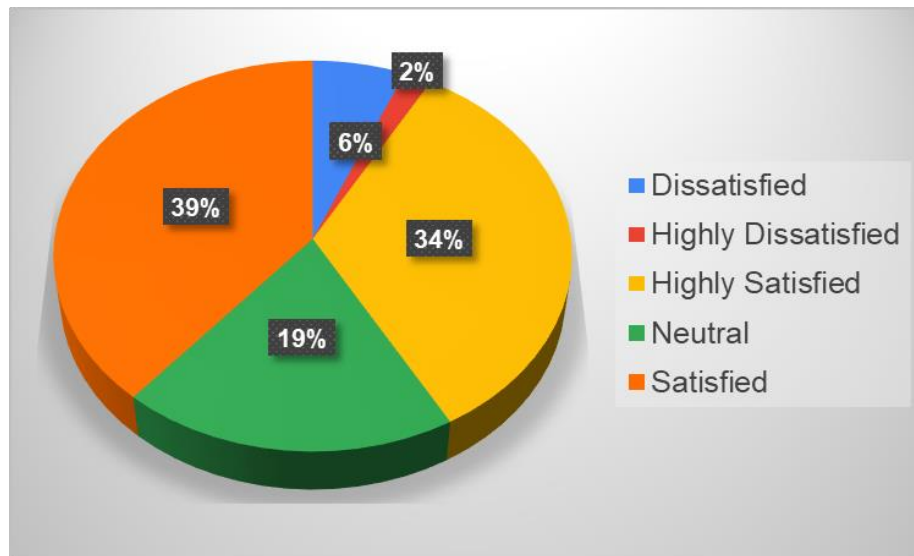

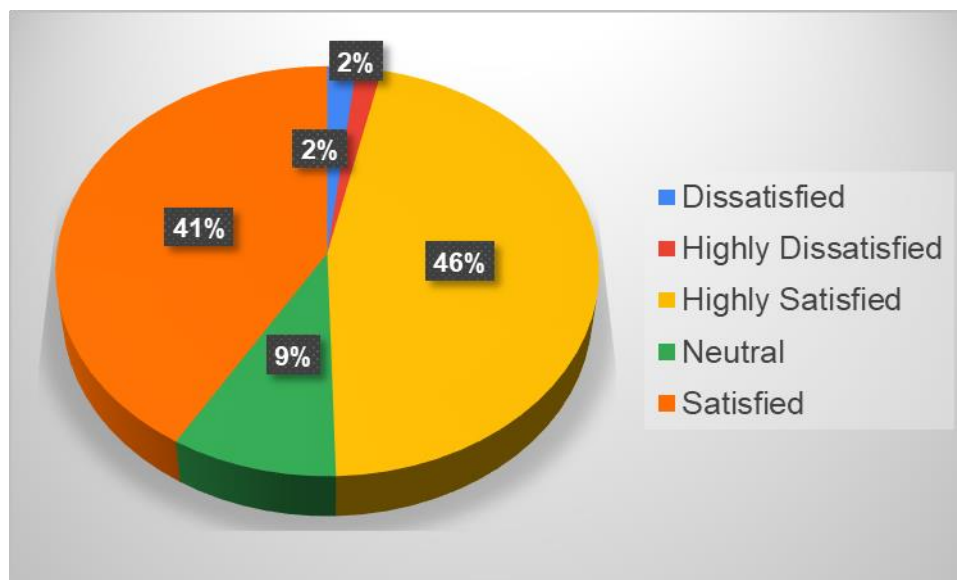

Percentage of students responded strongly in favour of this answer: **39 %**

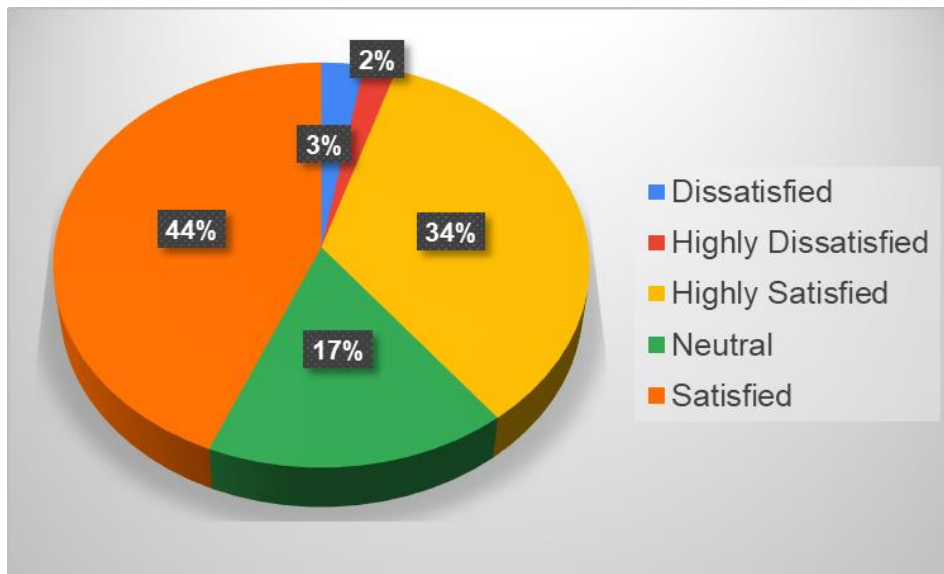
**10. Teacher(s) was available and helpful in clarifying doubts****Inference**

**11. Is the teacher providing appropriate learning materials in addition to class lectures?**

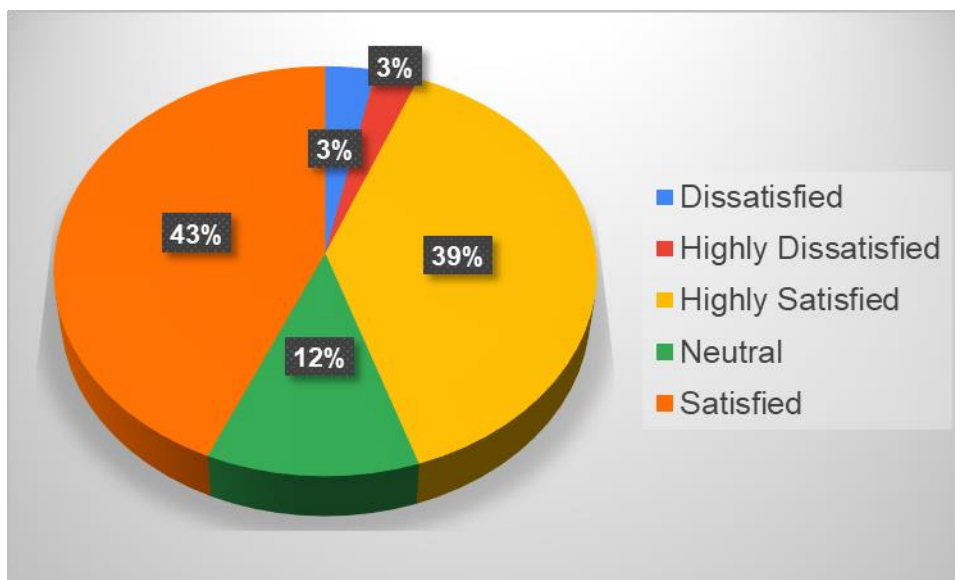
