## **DEPARTMENTS**

### **DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS**

#### **Association**

#### **Ozone Day Celebrations -2018**

The Departments of Physics and Botany jointly organized Ozone Day Celebrations (ODC -18) on 25th September 2018. This programme conducted with the financial assistance from KSCSTE was aimed to disseminate knowledge and create awareness about the need for conserving Ozone in the event of ongoing climate change scenario. It was inaugurated by Prof. K. C. Zachariah, the Principal of the College. Dr Elizabeth Thomas, HoD of Botany, Dr Praveen S., Department of Physics, and Dr Ninan Sajeeth Philip, HoD of Physics facilitated the occasion.

Dr K. K. Ramachandran, Senior Scientist National Centre for Earth Science Studies (NCESS) and Former Member Secretary Kerala State Council for Science Technology and Environment (KSCSTE), Government of Kerala, delivered the lead invited talk on the topic “Climate Change Scenario and Natural disaster Management” on the focal theme “Keep Cool and Carry On.” It was followed by an interactive session. ### Workshop on Synthesis of Nanomaterials

The Department of Physics hosted a two-day workshop on 15 and 16 October 2018 in collaboration with the Team MakeIntern (training partner of Becon event, IIT Delhi). The topic was “Synthesis of Nanomaterials.” Dr T. Theivasanthi, renowned researcher in the field of Nanomaterials, its synthesis and various applications, was the resource person. A total of 55 participants from all over Kerala took part in the same. Lectures and hands-on sessions were conducted for a comprehensive understanding of the wide applications of the subject. The various modules that were taken up were:

1. Introduction to Nanomaterials
2. Nanocomposites
3. Material Characterization
4. Nanotechnology in Energy conversions and biosensors
5. Nano-electronics, Nano-energetics and Nano-dielectrics

A written exam was conducted at the end of the lectures, to select 10 Students. It was followed by a group discussion. Five participants were then selected for the final round of the competition, to be held at IIT Kharagpur.

### Report on National Science Day Celebration 2019

On Wednesday, 27 February 2019, St Thomas College, Kozhencherry celebrated the National Science Day with the theme “Communicating science for all” under the auspices of the Department of Physics. Around 160 students, including students from nearby schools, participated in the celebrations. The welcome and introduction of the National Science Day was given by Dr Prathibha Vasudevan. Prof. K C Zachariah, the Principal, facilitated the occasion. Dr Senoy Thomas, Assistant professor, Department of Physics, CUSAT and former student of the college delivered the lead invited talk on the topic “Magnetic recording: current and future perspectives.” It was followed by an interactive session.



## Extension Activity

A science exhibition was conducted by the students of the Department for the students of nearby schools. The science exhibition “Sci-Scape 2K19” displayed, models and experiments covering the various aspects of science. The science exhibition was organized to promote participation and hands-on learning in science.
