➤ **HEALTH AND SANITARY CLASS FOR LP STUDENTS, KOZHENCHERRY L.P. SCHOOL**

NSS Secretary Miss. Nimmy Mony took classes on good health habits and importance of those habits in everyday life on 3/6/2018. Mr. Abin George Mathew led a quiz and painting competition regarding self-hygiene. School Head Mistress Lissy Mathew preside the programme and former HM Thomas sir inaugurated the programme.



➤ **EDUCATION AID FOR LP SCHOOL IN ADOPTED VILLAGE**

NSS Unit donated books to the LP school Kozhencherry to the students from our adopted village Kuragumala. We donated books, bags, new dresses to the students on June 3'2018. We handed over these materials to the Head mistress Lissy Mathew.



➤ **LIBRARY BOOK DONATION AT GOVERNMENT HIGH SCHOOL, PAZHAYATHERUVU**

In association with Health Department, NSS Unit conducted an awareness programme about diseases spread in time of rainfall on 16th June'2018. We visited every houses in Kurangumala and chlorinated every well and destroyed stagnated water which mosquito can occupy.



➤ **AWARENESS PROGRAMME PRECAUTIONS BEFORE RAINFALL AT KURANGUMALA**

In association with Kozhencherry Panchayat NSS Unit conducted an awareness programme in our adopted village Kurangumala. It was for reducing spread of communicable diseases during rainy season on June 18. 100 volunteers participated in the programme. They visited about 300houses and gave detailed brochure which included precautions for preventing seasonal communicable diseases.

➤ **SCI-SCAPE 2019-Science Exhibition**

On Wednesday, 27th February 2019, St. Thomas College, Kozhenchery hosted eminent physicists to celebrate the National Science Day. The National Science day is celebrated every year across India to mark the discovery of the *Raman Effect* on 28 February 1928 by Indian physicist, C.V. Raman, for which Raman received the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930. In 2019, government of India has directed to celebrate National Science Day with a theme “Communicating science for all”. The day-long event was organized by the Department of Physics, in which two brilliant physicists shared and showcased their original and impactful research and a science exhibition “**Sci- Scape 2K19**”. Around 160 students from our college and nearby schools participated in the celebrations. The celebrations began with invocation by the students. The welcome and introduction of the National Science day was given by the coordinator of the programme, Dr. Prathibha Vasudevan, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics, St. Thomas College. Hon. Principal, Prof. K C Zachariah, facilitated the occasion. In his speech, the principal discussed how the contribution of Science and Technology has revolutionized our day-to-day activities and made our life much easier.

The science exhibition “Sci-Scape 2K19” displays, models and experiments covering the various aspects of science. The science exhibition was organized to promote participatory and hands-on learning in Science. The activity aims at providing a common platform to students to give shape to their innovative ideas and learn from each other’s experiences. The exhibition also provides a medium for popularizing Science and increasing awareness among stakeholders about the close relationship between Science, Technology and Society. In this exhibition, the participating teams shared their creative ideas and solution to everyday challenges through their innovative working / non-working models, exhibits, projects and presentations supported by reports, display and research findings.



➤ **BIOSPARK-2018**

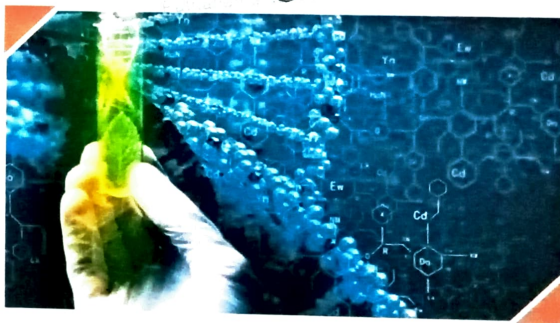
As a part of ensuring the availability of modern laboratory equipment and techniques to academically interested students, we at Department of Botany to organized an extension programme for higher secondary students "Biospark-2K18" on 7th December 2018. The programme aims to disseminate knowledge and create interest on modern biological techniques for the young minds. BIOSPARK 2K18 conveyed basic procedure and application of modern biological techniques including DNA isolation, Electrophoresis, Tissue culture,

Artificial Seed production etc. Technical sections on certain basic as well as advanced areas of biotechnology were held. School students were provided an exposure to field of biotechnology. 87 schools students attended this lecture-cum demonstration.
